Instructions for Boaters

1. By completing this form all Boaters and passengers agree to adhere to the Botany Bay Canal Fest code of practice for the weekend of the event.
2. Please note that designated moorings are not allocated beforehand and spaces are determined by Boaters on arrival. Unless booked separately as part of our VIP boaters event.
3. There will be reserved moorings allocated for the operators of boat rides and these spaces need to be kept free. All boats must be securely fastened with strong adequate mooring lines with Hi VIZ tape on rings or cleats.
4. All boats must be registered with the Canal & River Trust (British Waterways) and carry all relevant safety equipment and checks.
5. Boaters are responsible for own waste management and are asked to help keep the canal banks clean and tidy at all times.
6. Boaters are responsible for own safety whilst using the canal, however you must agree to abide by the festivals health and safety and management policy to moor your boat at the Botany Bay Canal Festival.
